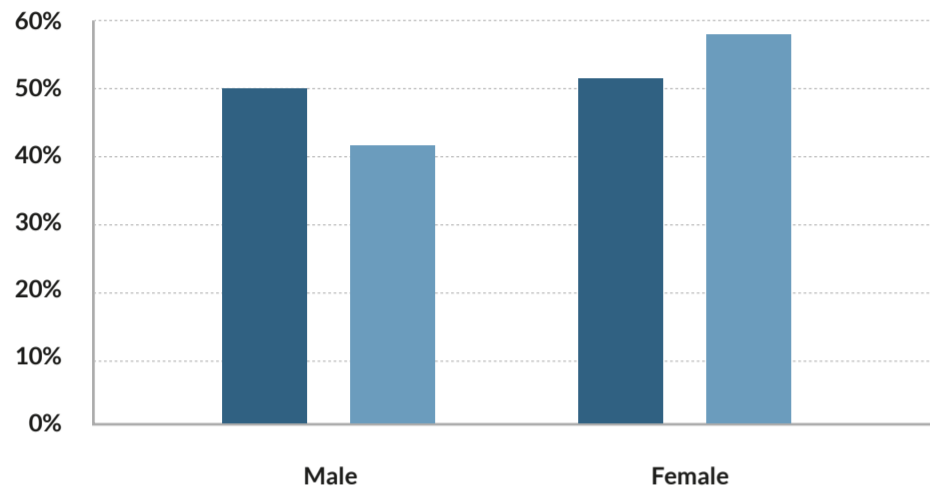

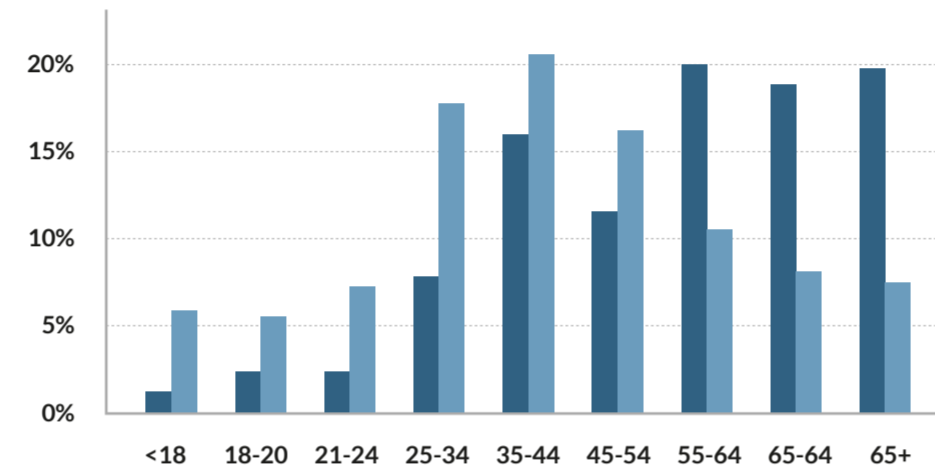

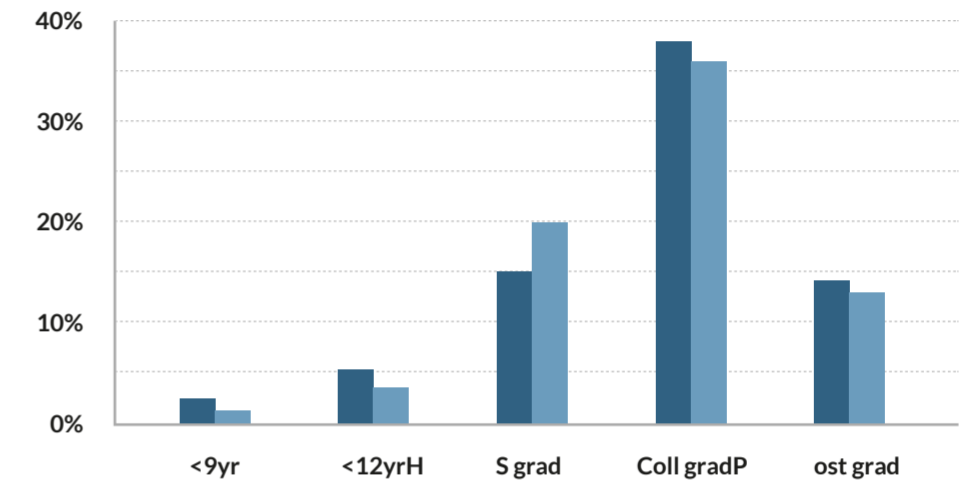

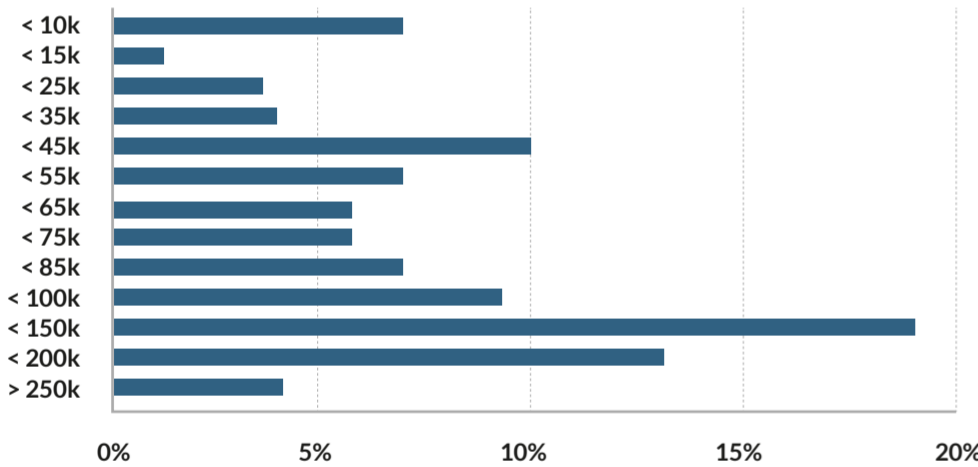

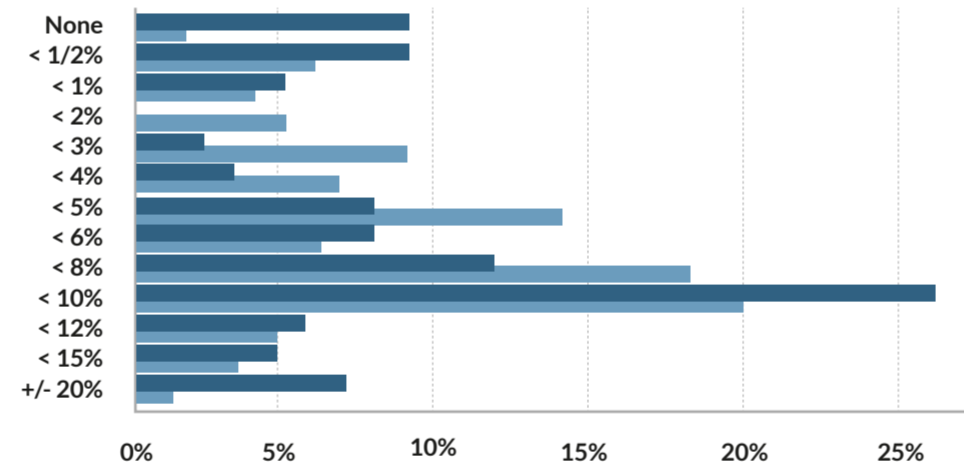

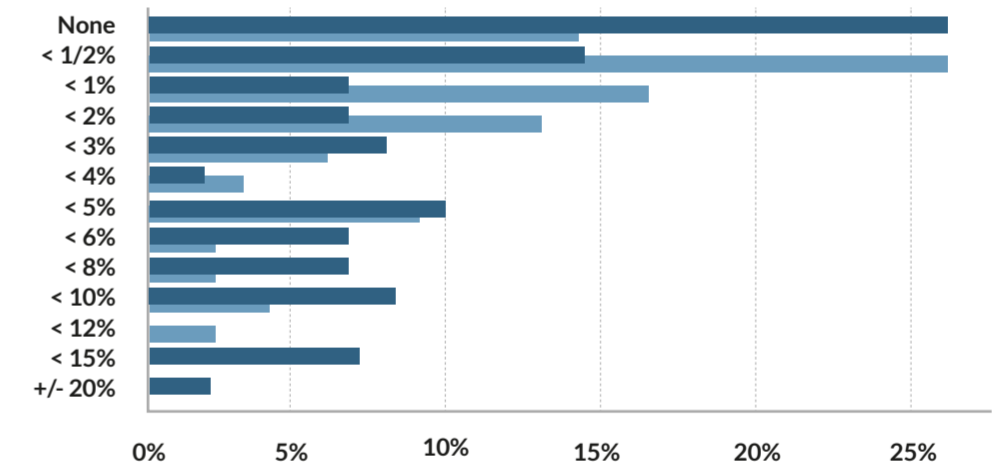

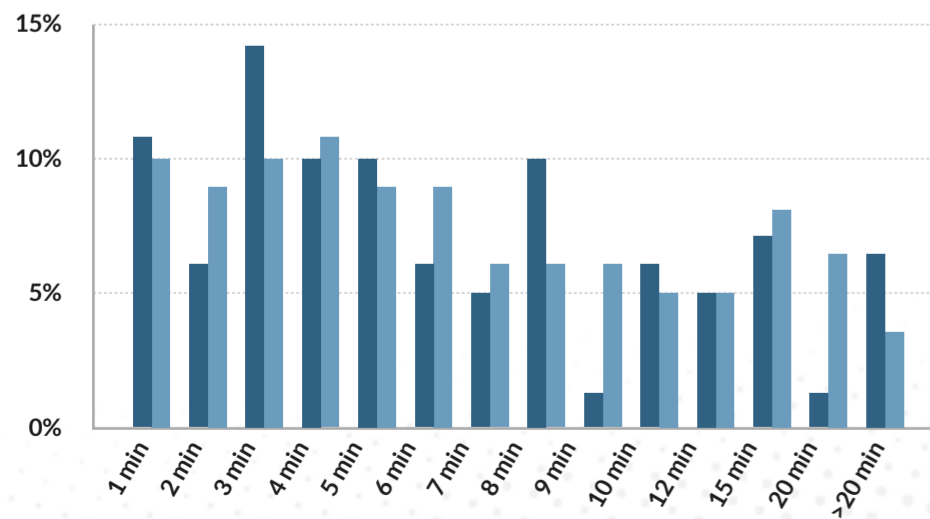

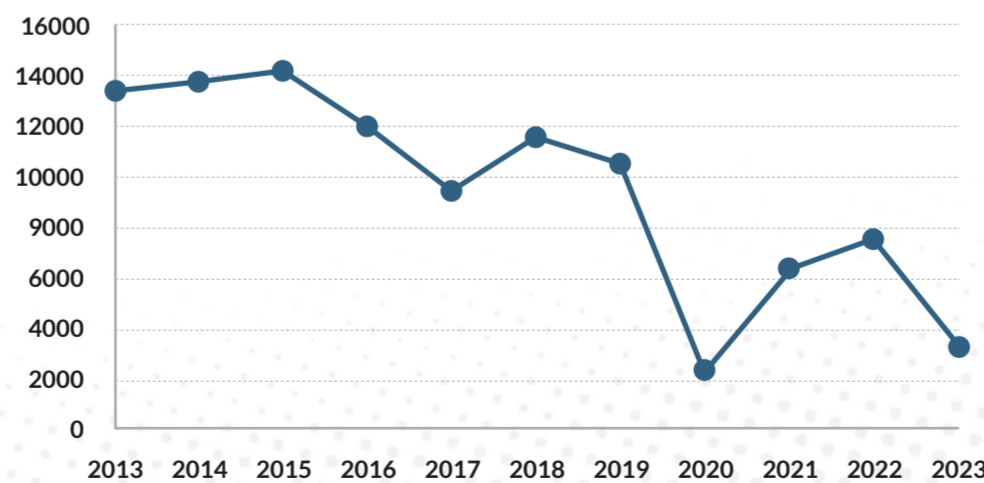

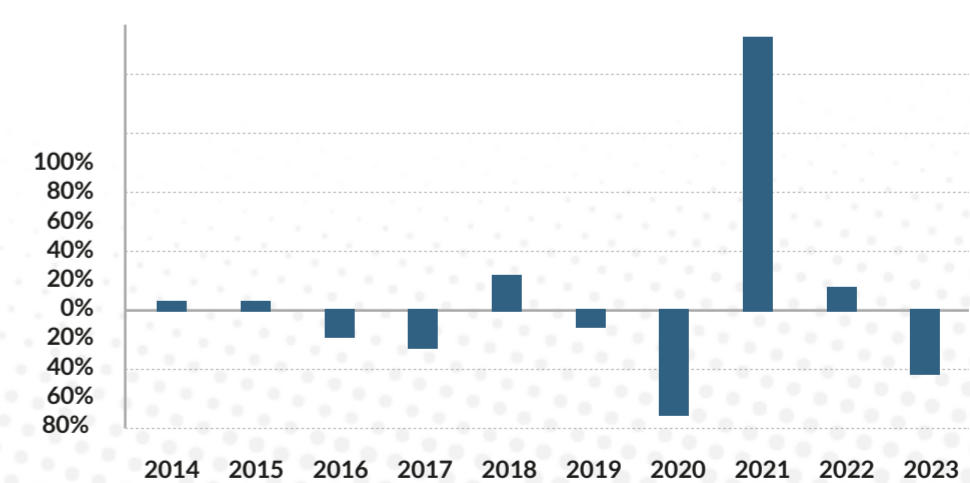
DISTANCE

WORSHIP

MISSIONS

Edgewood has a strong commitment to supporting missionaries working in unreached communities.

Our goal is to allot 20% of general fund giving to missions, and we will be doing a pledge drive this year to help us reach that goal.

We currently support 13 full-time missionaries/mission organizations.



SPANISH-SPEAKING

Our mission is to proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ to Hispanic families in the area through the preaching, teaching, discipleship, service to the community and fellowship in Christ, so they can come to the knowledge of the one true God and their lives can be edified upon the foundation which is Christ Jesus.

We offer Sunday services at 1 pm in Spanish. A discipleship program takes place weekly on Wednesdays on fb live.

On Sundays at noon we offer two different Sunday School classes and childcare.

The children’s Sunday School takes place at 1 pm during our worship service for kids from 2 years to 6 grade in Spanish.

Women’s Bible study is offered on Tuesdays and weekly prayer meetings on Fridays at 7 pm.



MINISTRIES

ADULT

To be in “community” with other believers is an essential part of the adult ministries at Edgewood. There are several opportunities for spiritual growth through Life Groups, Sunday School classes, Bible Studies, and Concerts of Prayer. It is our desire to provide ongoing growth opportunities that will hopefully engage the Edgewood community to become disciples who make disciples through the process of spiritual multiplication.



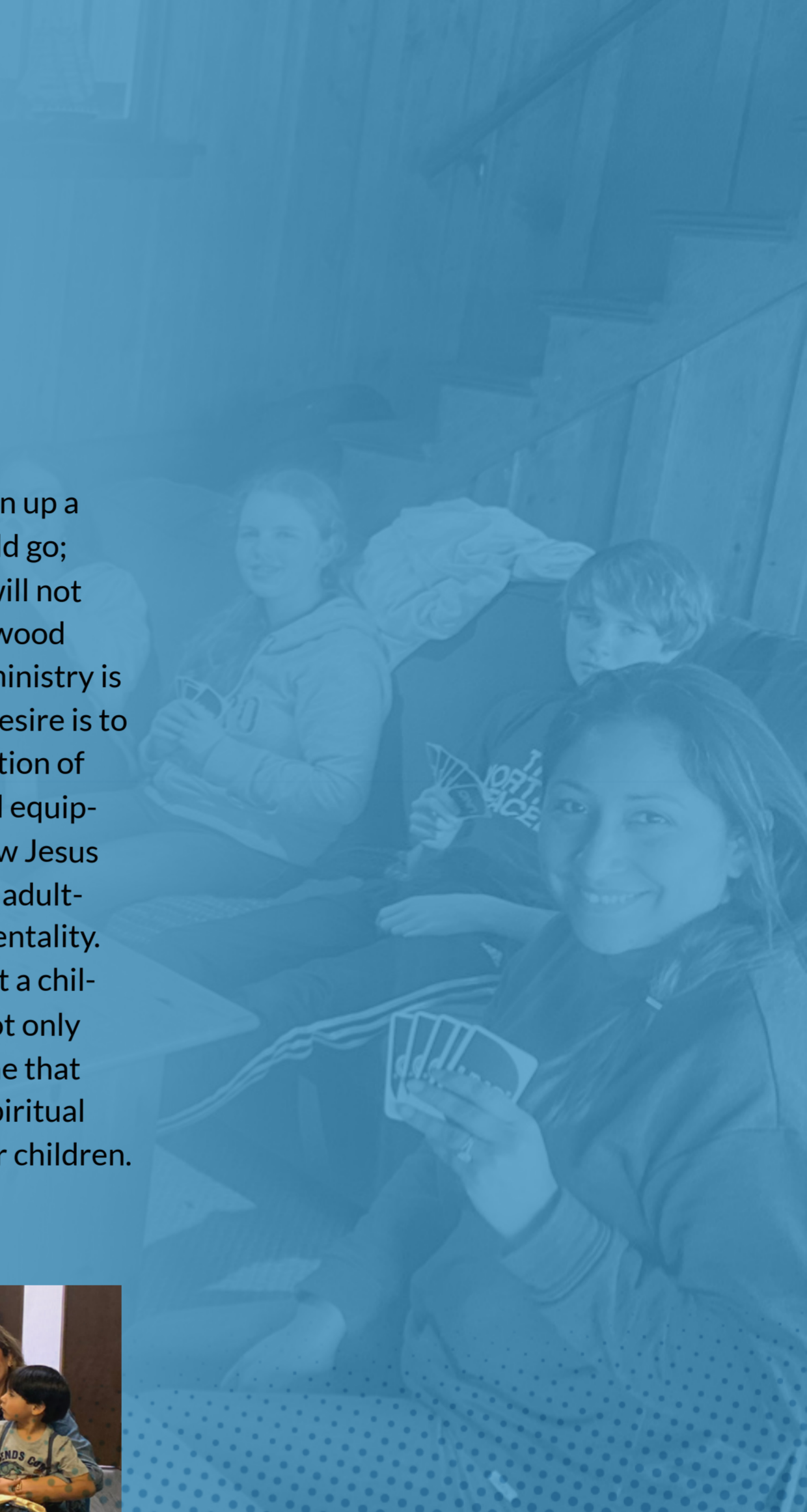
STUDENT

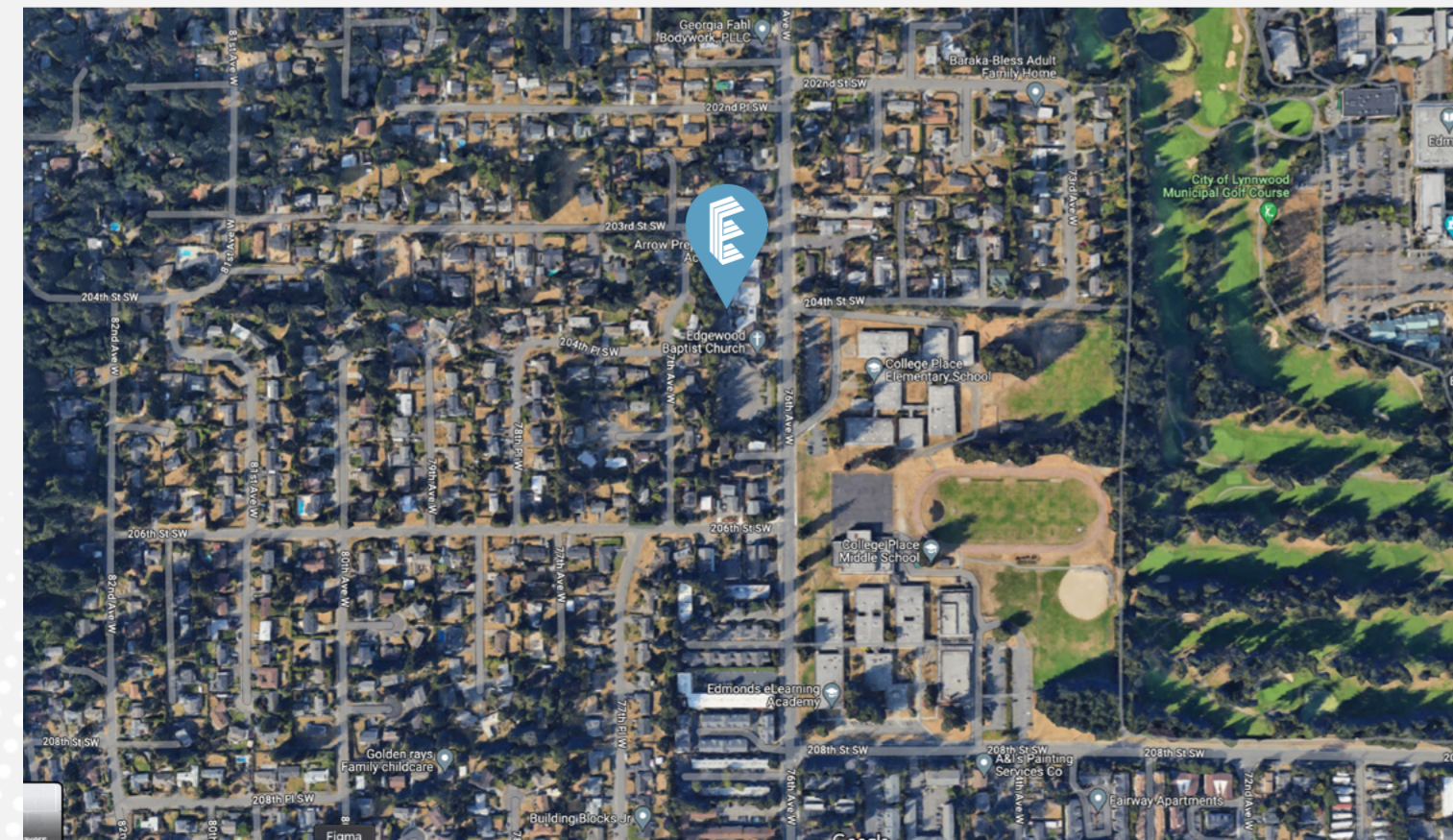

ABOUT OUR AREA

THE REGION

Located in Snohomish County, Edmonds is bounded by Puget Sound on the west and Lynnwood and Mountlake Terrace on the east. To the south is the city of Shoreline and north is an area of unincorporated Snohomish County.

While the city itself has an irregular border, it has a well-defined downtown area with a quaint small town look and feel. This includes a movie theater, a variety of restaurants and shops, and a stunning waterfront with parks and marinas. It is home to the headquarters and retail facility of Rick Steves' Europe Through the Back Door, a well-known PBS series by the same name. Edmonds is also the east terminus for the cross-sound ferry run between Edmonds and Kingston on the Kitsap peninsula.



ABOUT OUR AREA

AREA LIVING

There is a wide range of housing options in Edmonds and the surrounding area from expensive waterfront homes and view properties to condos and apartments, as well as more affordable housing in close proximity to the church.

Nearby Seattle has major league sports including the Seattle Seahawks, the Seattle Mariners and the Seattle Sounders and recently added Seattle Kraken hockey team. College football in the area includes the University of Washington Huskies.

Well-known and respected medical facilities include the Fred Hutch Cancer Center, UW Hospital, Swedish Hospital, and others. Swedish Edmonds Hospital, within one mile of the church, is Edmonds' largest employer.

Snohomish County's largest employer, The Boeing Company, has its commercial airplane assembly facility just north of Edmonds at the Everett plant. Final assembly for the majority of Boeing's commercial airplanes occurs there, as well as development of military aircraft and components of the SLS and Artemis space program.

Edgewood Church is currently seeking a Senior Pastor for their congregation. Located in Edmonds, Washington, this faith community is home for two separate congregations. One of these is Spanish-speaking with their own pastor, and the other is in English.

Edmonds is located along the shore of Puget Sound, just 15 miles north of downtown Seattle. The church of 175 attenders is seeking a Senior Pastor with excellent preaching skills and an emphasis on the Biblical text; a man who is relationally warm, involved in the local community, has a clear vision and possesses good leadership skills.
